It was really loud, but the funniest show I've seen in a long time

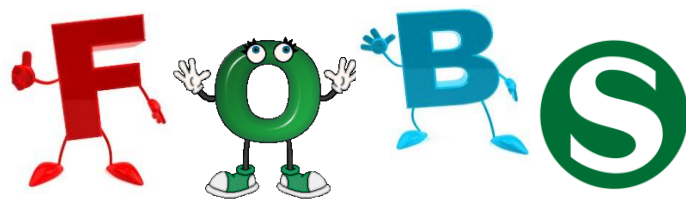
