Dear Parents

Many thanks for promptly returning the permission forms which were sent out last week.

Please note that our outside play equipment should only be used by children who are supervised by members of staff. Please can you ensure your children do not play on the equipment before or after school as we cannot guarantee their safety. As many parents are aware, attendance is a whole school priority at Bugle School. Our attendance policy has recently been updated and we are starting to ask parents to complete a form on their child's return following an absence. We ask that parents please complete and return these forms which will be sent home in book bags, so we can closely monitor absence levels.

As a school, we can receive extra funding, known as Pupil Premium for children who are recorded as being eligible to receive Free School Meals. This funding supports the additional services we offer to our children to ensure all are able to achieve their full potential. Please see further details regarding FSM below.

Kernow Health forms accompany this newsletter (for Reception, Years 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5). Please note that if you require access to a computer to complete the online form, we can help. Please come into school and speak to a member of the office staff.

Is your child eligible for Free School Meals? Your child may be eligible for free school meals if you (or the child themselves in their own right) is in receipt of any of the following benefits.

- Income Support (IS).
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190.

- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC).
- Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support.
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods.

Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM)

All Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) pupils are entitled to receive a free school meal as part of the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) initiative, regardless of what benefits are being claimed.

If you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed above which would entitle your child to free school meals, your school could claim Pupil Premium funding to support your child's education, just by you completing an application form.
